| 2. | <u>Treasurer Updates</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Need to chase people for kit money- Asked Assistant Dean for money to pay for coaching, an increase of £600.- Club Account has now been spent up to its usual float amount.- Note some Subs have yet to be paid- Treasurer to chase £187 for the repair of a cox box that another College broke.<ol style="list-style-type: none">A. Boatclub cocktails: made a profit.B. Coaching fees: W1 needs £180 (7 outings). Chapman is charging £15 per session, and the Boatclub have paid him £345C. Subs for Trinity: Constitutionally, members of the Boat Club are not allowed to race if they haven't paid subs- President will take people out of crews as only members covered by insurance.- Treasurer to list rowers with outstanding subs for respective boat captains- Should allow for certain members to apply for a reduction of subs. Constitutionally, allowed 2 per annum, applications to open in 4th week- Speak to JCR Access and Admissions Officer about this (overlooked) bursary.<ol style="list-style-type: none">D. Mens New Boat: College has a trust fund that allows for a new boat every 6 years. |

| 4. | <p><u>Blazers & Kit Fund.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cheapest Blazer option is £160 - First boat limited and each member to buy their own – captains of first boats to send out email to the first boats - Ask JCR if money given by them for a kit-grant pot could be used for Blazers. - JCR Treasurer has said we are likely to get circa. £500 for a kit fund. - Stagger the amount of aid we get from the JCR so the people who need it the most gets more money |
